- **3. Collections:** Before the Association turns over a delinquent account of an Owner to a collection agency or refers it to an attorney for legal action, the Association must send the Owner a notice of delinquency specifying:
  - 3a. The total amount due, with an accounting of how the total was determined;
  - **3b.** Whether the opportunity to enter into a payment plan exists and instructions for contracting the entity to enter into such a payment plan;
  - **3c.** The name and contact information for the individual the Owner may contact to request a copy of the Owner's ledger in order to verify the amount of the debt; and
  - **3d.** That action is required to cure the delinquency and the failure to do so within thirty (30) days may result in Owner's delinquent account being turned over to a collection agency, a lawsuit being filed against the Owner, the filing and foreclosure of a lien against the Owner's property, or other remedies available under Colorado law.
- **4. Application of Late Payments:** The Association may apply all payments received on account of any Owner in this order:
  - 4a. to the payment of any and all legal fees and costs (including attorney fees);
  - 4b. to the costs and expenses of enforcement and collections;
  - **4c.** to late charges, interest, returned check charges, lien fees and other costs owing or incurred with respect to such owner;
  - **4d.** any remaining amounts shall be applied to the assessments, other charges or fines due with respect to such owner.
  - **4e.** For purposes of collecting an outstanding judgement, the Association may, but shall not be required, to first apply payments received following entry of a judgement towards post-judgement attorney's fees and costs, assessments, or other charges coming due following the entry of the judgement.
